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Making data meet marine public policies needs at the right scale and resolution

- Maritime Spatial Planning and Maritime Strategy Framework Directives:
 - Encourage results to be publicly available with no specifics on format or location
 - Based on a wide range of <u>data</u> (environmental, human activities...) <u>of reference</u> (up-to-date, high-quality...)
 - Data from both Directives are not all available on EMODnet but addition process on-going

- Bathymetric Portal:
 - >10 years of continuous improvement
 - Possible access to the latest 3 sets of Digital Terrain Model for each Sea Basin
 - DTM enables to improve modeling of the physical marine environment (tides, waves, weather...)
 - Brick for the Digital Twin of the Ocean
- EMODnet provides an integrated view for scientists and policy-makers :
 - Access to all the data related to maritime environment through one single portal only
 - Extensive amount of data, though organised and harmonised,
- Data quality compliant with EU Directives (INSPIRE, OPEN Data...)
- European, Sea Basin and transborder integrated view
