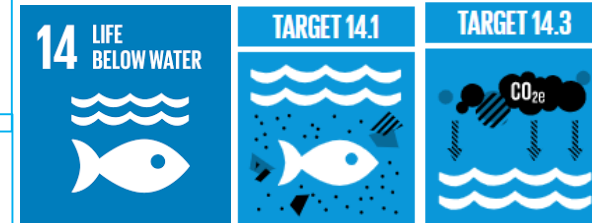
- ❖ EMODnet Chemistry focus and links with SDGs
- ❖ Efforts to collect **users’ needs** (data, products, Data Quality, metadata, “ancillary data”) and to involved in **global initiatives to improve interoperability, data Quality & comparability**

- ✓ Align metadata → interoperability
- ✓ Align vocabularies → interoperability
- ✓ Improve Quality: QA/QC information & procedures → transparency
- ✓ Implementation of guidelines → Ocean «best practices»
