## MSFD

- Regionally agreed integrated assessment results (RSC QSRs / Assessments) and underlying data is made available for MSFD reporting, including preparing **prefilled indicator results and data**. Including possibility to apply prefilled reporting sheets should be helpful for MS.
- MSFD reporting requirements
  - GES / notGES (Art 8. reporting scheme, well defined)
  - Underlying data:
    - Assessment data must be approved by MSs, and from regular monitoring scheme. Resources for adequate regular monitoring are required
    - It must be possible to refer to an underlying assessment dataset with single URL (URL / DOI)

## MSPD

- Planning data (zoning elements) is recommended to made publicly available (no reporting) according to agreed format and data model
- Collected to regional and European platforms:
  - BASEMAPS (Baltic)
  - EMODnet (EU)
- EMODnet serves as a platform for making this planning data available, including also other human activities datasets
